

BANDAGE/SPLINT CARE INSTRUCTIONS

If a bandage or splint has been applied to your pet,

- Check the bandage or splint daily. There should be no swelling, pain, odor, or discharge.
- Do not allow your pet to lick or chew at the splint or bandage.
- Keep the splint/bandage dry. Do not bathe your pet or allow it to go swimming while the splint or bandage is on. If the ground is wet or it is raining when your pet goes outside, cover the end of the bandage or splint with a plastic bag and tape it in place to protect it.

If you notice any of abnormalities listed above, or if the splint/bandage gets wet or damaged, bring your pet in immediately for a recheck and to have the bandage/splint replaced.
