

Home Care for Pets after Dental Procedures

- * Keep your pet quiet for a day or two after returning home. Your pet will most likely be a little bit groggy and slow-moving for a couple days due to the anesthesia.
- * No food or water for 12 hours. After this time, you can offer your pet a small amount of water and food every few hours. Giving too much of either too soon can cause stomach upset and lead to vomiting.
- * If your pet had tooth extractions, feed a soft pet food for 3-4 days. After that time slowly switch your pet back to its regular diet by mixing the two together over a couple days' time.
