

HOME CARE FOR PETS AFTER SURGICAL PROCEDURES

- * Keep your pet quiet for a day or two after returning home. Your pet will most likely be a little groggy the first couple days after surgery.
- * Check your pet's incision daily. It may be a little pink or swollen, but there should be no redness or discharge.
- * Do not allow your pet to lick or chew at its incision.
- * Do not allow the sutures to get wet. No baths or swimming until the sutures are removed or for one week if suture removal is not necessary.
- * Return in one week for suture removal and recheck. Please call before coming in.
- * If the incision looks abnormal to you or you think your pet is not acting well, or if you have any questions regarding your pet's condition, call the clinic immediately. Telephone (409) 389-2200
